In accordance with the guidance from the Centers for Disease Control, the Federal Government, and Governor Murphy's Administration, the City of Pleasantville is implementing the following order for all Pleasantville residents, businesses, and public spaces:

- 1. Pleasantville City Council Meeting for tonight will be postponed until further notice**
- 2. Planning and Zoning Board Meetings closed until further notice**
- 3. All Pleasantville Recreation programs are closed until April 20**
- 4. The Pleasantville Bus Station will be closed until further notice**
- 5. All buildings held by the City of Pleasantville will be closed to public access for persons without an appointment. Contact 609 484-3600 during normal business hours to schedule an appointment.**
- 6. All restaurants will be closed to dine-in service. Take-out service will remain available.**
- 7. All retail businesses will be ordered to close daily from 800 PM until 500 AM unless they are considered essential to residents. Essential businesses include food stores, pharmacies, and gas stations.**
- 8. All bars and nightclubs are closed until further notice**
- 9. All public events, even those already approved by permit must be reviewed by City Hall prior to the event or cancel the event.**

The Office of Emergency Management strongly encourages all residents to eliminate unnecessary travel and interaction with others. While there is no restriction on travel, it is not recommended unless truly necessary.

We will continue to monitor this evolving situation with our Emergency Management partners and City Leaders. We will provide updates as soon as they become available.
