



Construction of upgrades and improvements to South Franklin Boulevard and East Bayview Avenue (\$2,188,119.95) were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits by upgrading the existing roadways and replacing sanitary sewer mains in kind which will assist in preventing ground water and surface water contamination for residents and businesses in the City of Pleasantville.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
