- Identification for all members in the household
 - Social Security cards, birth certificates for infants under 12 months.
 - Proof of U.S. Citizenship or Legal Residency
- Proof of Income (Earned and Unearned)
 - Last 2 pay stubs if you get paid biweekly or last 4 pay stubs for weekly pay
 - Self-employment
 - Pension
 - Unemployment
 - Child support/Alimony
 - Rental Income
 - TANF/General Assistance
 - Interest or Dividends
- Copy of lease or mortgage
- Most current Energy Bills
- Public Housing/Rental Assistance
